

# COLLEGE TRANSFER PATHWAY: Associate in Science



## Career & College Promise (CCP)

CCP provides opportunities for eligible NC high school students to take tuition-free, college courses for dual credit (some students may have to pay for textbooks and materials). Taking CCP courses accelerates completion of college certificates, diplomas, applied associate degrees that provide entry-level job skills, and associate degrees that lead to transfer within the UNC System of 4-year colleges and universities and many private institutions.

## Eligibility Requirements for College Transfer Pathways (CTP)

- High School Junior or Senior
- Weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Demonstrate college readiness in English, reading, and math on an approved assessment (Pre-ACT, ACT, PSAT, SAT, College Placement test)

## Eligibility Requirements - Provisional Enrollment status in CT Pathways:

- Weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Completed 2 years of HS English with "C" or higher
- Completed HS Algebra II or Math III, or higher with "C" or higher
- Written approval from HS principal/designee and WCC chief academic officer/chief student development administrator
- Students may only register for college level English or Math
- If they earn a C in these courses or in combination with benchmark scores, they are no longer considered provisional
- Under provisional status, students may not be enrolled in another pathway

## Transferring Courses to 4-year Colleges/Universities:

- The Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA) is a state-wide agreement that guarantees transferable courses completed with a 'C' or higher at NC Community Colleges will transfer to NC public universities and many private institutions.
- Students should check with the 4-year institution they plan to attend regarding how transferable courses apply to potential major
- Students should review 4 year baccalaureate degree plans posted online for specific majors at the 4-year institutions
