

# Evening Program

Wilson Community College's Evening Program is designed to provide students a pathway to earn an Associate's degree in two years (six semesters including summer semesters), attending face-to-face classes exclusively in the evening. Students will attend class twice each week. A typical course load will be approximately 4 classes, or about 12 semester hours credit.



## Available Degrees

Through the Wilson Community College Evening Program, students can earn the following degrees from start to finish:

- Associate of Arts – for transfer to a four-year college or university.
- Associate of Science – for transfer to a four-year college or university.
- Business Administration – an associate in applied science degree, preparing students for employment in government agencies, financial institutions, or small and large business or industry. Many of these courses will also transfer to four-year colleges and universities.

## Noteworthy Features

- Students will attend class two nights each week for 2 or 3 hours each night.
- Each class will have a classroom meeting 8 times during the 16-week semester. For example, a student taking four classes would attend two of the classes the first week, and the other two during the second week, repeating this pattern of meeting classes in alternating weeks throughout the semester.
- All classes are offered in a hybrid format, which means instruction is delivered both face-to-face and online.
- In order to be successful, students will need to possess good basic computer skills, have consistent access to a computer, and a dependable Internet connection. These resources, as well as training for them, are available on the Wilson Community College campus.
- Completing a degree in 2 years will require approximately 4 courses (12 Semester Hours Credit) per semester. However, students may choose to take fewer courses.
