## Career & College Promise (CCP)

Career & College Promise (CCP) provides opportunities for eligible high school students to start college early, where courses can count for dual credit, all **TUITION-FREE** (some students may have to pay for textbooks and supplies)! CCP students accelerate completion of college certificates, diplomas, and associate degrees that provide entry-level job skills and/or lead to college transfer credit within the UNC System of 4-year colleges and universities and many private institutions.

## Eligibility Requirements for College Transfer Pathways (CTP)

- High School Junior or Senior
- Unweighted GPA of 2.8 or higher; **OR**,
- Demonstrate college readiness in English, reading, and math on an approved assessment

## General Admission Requirements

- College CCP Admissions Application
- High School Transcript
- Registration and Verification Form

## Transferring Courses to 4-year Colleges/Universities:

- The Uniform Articulation Agreement (AFA) focuses on seamless transfer for students who begin music studies at a community college and then transfer to UNC system and Independent Colleges/Universities Bachelor in Music programs.

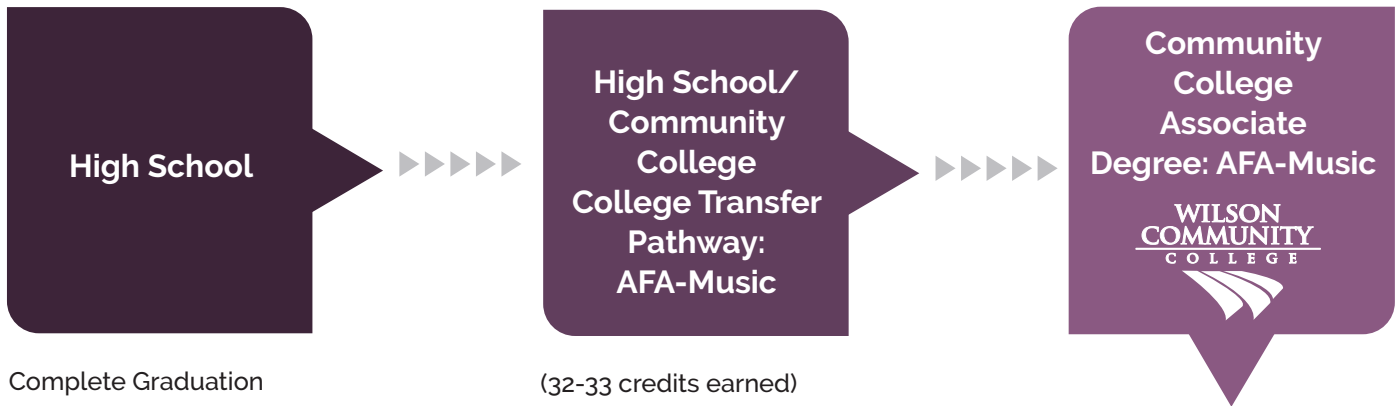

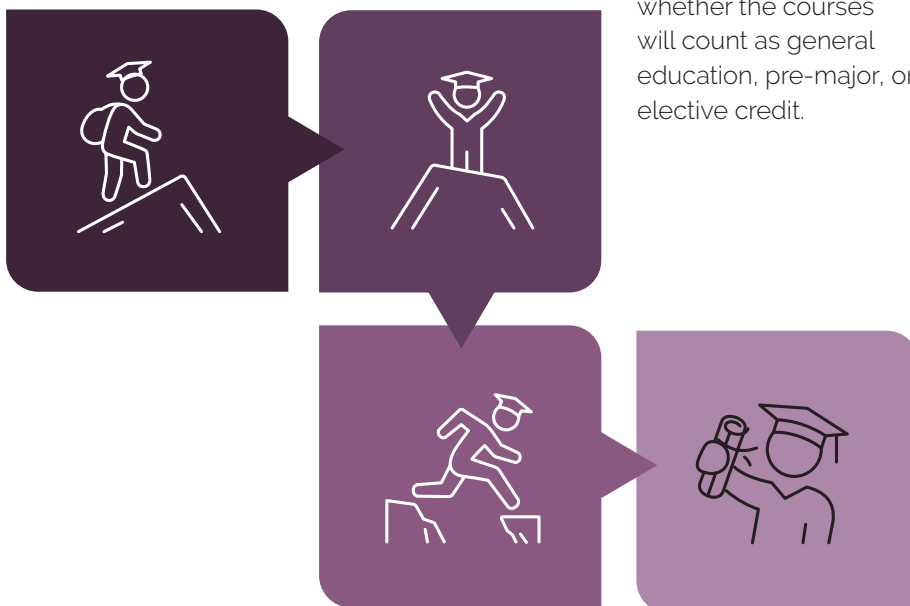
