Career & College Promise (CCP)

Eligibility Requirements

- · High School Junior or Senior
- Unweighted GPA of 2.8 or higher, <u>OR</u>, demonstrate college readiness in English, reading and math on approved assessments.
- If GPA is below 2.8, principles/designees can waive the GPA and provide rationale for waiver.



About the Community Spanish Interpreter Pathway:

This pathway is a set of courses that students can take to earn a certificate toward the Associate of Applied Science Community Spanish Interpreter Degree. These courses prepare students to work as entry-level bilingual professionals who will provide communication access in interviews and interactive settings.
