

CCP students must provide high school transcripts as part of the application process. Wilson County Traditional public school transcripts are provided for students.

Transcripts are used for initial CCP eligibility verification and provided each semester a student enrolls in CCP courses to show continued high school enrollment and progress toward high school graduation.

The high school transcripts must include the following (unofficial transcripts are acceptable):

- Student's Legal Name
- Date of Birth
- Contact information (HS Principal/designee or Homeschool Administrator's email & phone number)
- Projected/expected graduation date
- Student grade level (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th with the corresponding academic years)
- completed high school course grades that correspond to the grade levels; AND
- current In-progress classes (noted as IP or grade area left blank)
- The unweighted, cumulative high school GPA on a 4.0 grade scale

****Homeschool Additional Notes:**

- Provide a copy of the Homeschool ID and registration record
- List all courses from all previous schools or curricula that you incorporate in your homeschool transcript.
